### **Zetts semifinalist for Draddy Trophy**

YOUNGSTOWN — Senior quarterback Tom Zetts has been named a semifinalist for the 2007 Draddy Trophy, which recognizes an individual who combines academic success and football performance with exemplary community leadership.

Selected as the best and the brightest from the college gridiron, The National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF) has selected 153 semifinalists for the 2007 Draddy Trophy, presented by HealthSouth, and the candidates for the NFF 2007 National Scholar-Athlete Awards.
